INTRODUCTION

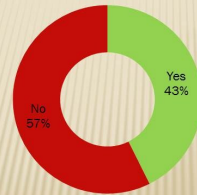
* We decided to do a project on which hot beverage is more popular in our school, Tea or Coffee. We wanted to find out which drink and what brands people preferred.

DO YOU DRINK COFFEE?

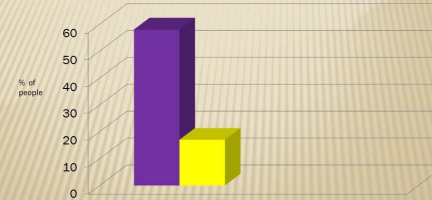
Do You Drink Coffee

On Average 42.6% of people in our school drink coffee.

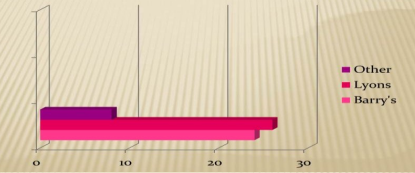
DO YOU DRINK TEA?

* On average 77.33% drink Tea.

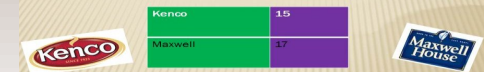
WHAT BRAND OF TEA DO YOU DRINK?

WHICH IS YOUR PREFERRED BRAND OF COFFEE?



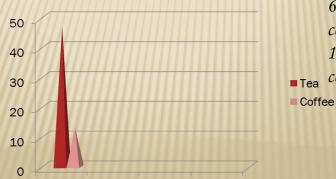
WHAT IS YOUR PREFERRED BRAND OF COFFEE?

As you can see from our graph 47 people out of 60 prefer tea compared to the 13 that prefer coffee.

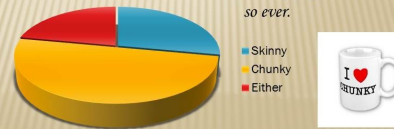


DO YOU PREFER A SKINNY OR CHUNKY MUG?

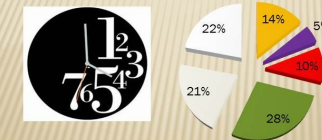
In our school 58% do not take sugar in their tea or coffee.

Favourite Time?

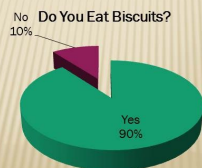
