## The 2 Degree Tipping Point

This states that if the temperature of the atmosphere rises above 2°c of pre-industrial levels, the earth will become an unsafe habitat for humans. The lives of billions of people will be compromised due to:

- From rising sea levels of 10's of metres.
- Massive desert expansion to over 70% of the globe.
- Catastrophic species extinction
- Wide scale food shortages and
- Highly increased levels of disease among humans.

### <u>Aims</u>

We carried out our survey on 40 teenagers and 40 adults.


- One of our aims was to investigate any differences between teenagers and adults in their awareness of the tipping point.
- We wanted to raise awareness of the 2°c Tipping Point.
- We also wanted to educate people on the topic. In our survey we included a big red stop sign towards the end and we explained what it was to people before they answered the last three questions.
- We wanted to find out if it concerned them after learning about it and we also wanted to find out if they would make any changes to their lifestyles.


Have you ever heard of the '2 Degree Tipping 'Point'?

The graph shows us that both adults and teenagers have very little awareness of the '2 Degree Tipping Point'. A huge 71% of people have never heard of it before which we found a quite concerning statistic.


We then asked people would they be willing to make changes to their lifestyle. We were surprised to learn that 94% of people would make changes which is positive.

In Q.4 on our survey we told people that, "Temperatures will rise. There is about a 50% chance of keeping temperature rise below 2 degrees if we act now". We asked them was this statement true and 82.5% of people said this was true. But in Q.9 only 40% of people said they would make big changes which is upsetting.





After people were made aware of the 2°c Tipping Point at the end of the survey we asked if it concerned them or not. We were happy to learn that 91% of them said it concerned them considering 71% of people had never heard of it before.



# Tipping Point






In your lifetime how many people do you think will be affected by sea level rises?









People were asked did they think the '2 Degree Tipping Point' would have a negative effect on human health, such as dehydration, diseases through food, water and animals, and deaths from extreme weather events etc.


91% of people said yes and 9% said no. We were happy with this result but we feel not enough people want to make real changes especially being aware of the consequences.



People's responses showed us that most do not have a clue about the effects of the '2 Degree Tipping Point'.

25% of the earths surface is already covered by desert and the majority of people answered 20% or less....This worries us...**Why?** 








The statistics of this questions showed us that nobody has a clue of the severity of passing the 2 degree tipping point.

Nearly 70% of people are way off the correct answer of 100million+. People don't see the real danger which is alarming. It is predicted that over 2 billion people will be displaced by sea level rises!



Right now, over 900million people in the world go to bed hungry. From this data we can see that only 24% of people believe that the number of starving people will go over 1 Billion.



In our last question we asked people had taking part in the survey benefited them in anyway. We were very happy to learn that over 85% of people said it did benefit them. We also asked them how it had benefited them and this is some of the feedback we received:


The majority of people said that they had been made more aware of the issue.
