

Continued falls in both long and short-term claimants

In the twelve months to April 2000, the decrease of 35,969 persons on the Live Register comprised of a fall of 11,939 for short-term claimants and 24,030 for long-term claimants (i.e. those signing on for more than one year).

In April 2000, less than 40% of claimants were long-term. This compares with 44% one year previously when there were 87,630 persons signing on for over a year, and 45% in April 1998 when there were 105,081 long-term claimants. See Table 1.

Other features include:

- ♦ In April 2000, 45% of males and 31% of females on the Live Register were long-term claimants. See Table 1.
- In the year to April 2000, the number of men and women claimants fell in almost all of the age groups but there was a slight increase for women aged 55 and over. The steepest falls for both men and women were in the 25 to 34 age group. See Table 2.
- One quarter of male claimants have been on the register for under three months. A further quarter have been on the register for three years or more. This compares with 36% of female claimants who have been signing on for less than three months and 13% who have been signing on for three or more years. See Table 5b.
- Overall, 20% of claimants have been on the Live Register for three or more years. At regional level, the percentage signing on for three or more years ranges from 16% in the Mid-East region to 24% in the South-West. See Table 7.

The Live Register is not designed to measure unemployment. It includes part-time workers (those who work up to three days a week), seasonal and casual workers entitled to Unemployment Assistance or Benefit. Unemployment is measured by the Quarterly National Household Survey and the latest figure, for Dec-Feb 2000, is 81,500 persons unemployed.

Background Notes	
Source and scope of the Live Register	Live Register statistics are compiled from returns made directly to the Central Statistics Office by each local office of the Department of Social, Community and Family Affairs. The Live Register comprises persons under 65 years of age in the following classes:
	 All Claimants for Unemployment Benefit (UB) excluding systematic short-time workers; Applicants for Unemployment Assistance (UA) excluding smallholders and self-employed persons; Other registrants including applicants for credited Social Welfare contributions but excluding those directly involved in an industrial dispute.
	The monthly Live Register statistics relate to the situation on the last Friday of the month.
Age by Duration Analysis	The current series of half-yearly age by duration analyses of the Live Register was introduced in April 1989. At that time, January and July age analyses which did not cover duration were discontinued and more detailed duration categories were included in the April and October statistics. The age by duration analysis usually relates to the second-last Friday of April and October. The totals in the release are therefore, normally close but not identical to the corresponding end-of-month Live Register totals.
Descriptive articles	The compilation basis for the Live Register statistics from May 1992 onwards is described in the September 1992 issue of the <i>Statistical Bulletin</i> . The March 1980 issue contained a description of the basis used up to April 1992 while a more comprehensive treatment of Live Register statistics appeared in the "Report of the Inter-Departmental Study Group on Unemployment Statistics" (Stationery Office Dublin, Prl. 7925, April 1979). The results of a special study of the differences between the Labour Force Survey (LFS) Estimates of Unemployment and the Live Register are contained in the December 1996 issue of the <i>Statistical Bulletin</i> .
Unemployment statistics	Unemployment is measured by the QuarterlyNational Household survey (formerly the annual Labour Force survey). The Live Register is not designed to measure unemployment.
