

Standardised Unemployment Rate falls to 4.5%

The Live Register increased by 3,882 persons in June to reach 156,753 at the end of the month.

The number of persons signing on usually increases in June each year, due mainly to the seasonal effect of schools and colleges closing for summer holidays. After adjusting for seasonal factors, the underlying trend in June was a fall of 4,200 persons. As a result the Standardised Unemployment Rate is estimated to have fallen to 4.5%. See Table 7 and Background Notes.

In the twelve months since June 1999, when there were 195,519 persons signing on, the Live Register has fallen by 38,766.

Other features include:

- The number of females on the Live Register increased by 4,042 in June and the number of males fell by 160. See Table 1a.
- The number of UB claimants rose by 3,162 in June while the number of UA applicants aged under 25 increased by 1,440 in the month. See Tables 1a and 1b.
- After adjusting for seasonality, there was an underlying fall of 2,700 for males and 1,500 for females in June. See Table 4a.
- The standardised unemployment rate in June was 4.5%. This compares with 5.7% in April 1999 based on the Quarterly National Household Survey. See Table 8 and Background Notes.

The Live Register is not designed to measure unemployment. It includes parttime workers (those who work up to three days a week), seasonal and casual workers entitled to Unemployment Assistance or Benefit. Unemployment is measured by the Quarterly National Household Survey and the latest figure, for December-February 2000, is 81,500 persons unemployed.

Central Statistics Office Live Register Statement

Background Notes

Source and The Live Register is compiled from returns made directly to the Central Statistics Office by each scope of the local office of the Department of Social, Community and Family Affairs. It comprises persons **Live Register** under 65 years of age in the following classes:

- All Claimants for Unemployment Benefit (UB) excluding systematic short-time workers (see Table 5);
- Applicants for Unemployment Assistance (UA) excluding smallholders/farm assists and self-employed persons (see Table 6);
- Other registrants including applicants for credited Social Welfare contributions but excluding those directly involved in an industrial dispute (see Table 6).

Descriptive The compilation basis for the Live Register statistics from May 1992 onwards is described in the September 1992 issue of the Statistical Bulletin. The March 1980 issue contained a description of the basis used up to April 1992 while a more comprehensive treatment of Live Register statistics appeared in the "Report of the Inter-Departmental Study Group on Unemployment Statistics" (Stationery Office Dublin, Prl. 7925, April 1979). The results of a special study of the differences between the Labour Force Survey (LFS) Estimates of Unemployment and the Live Register are contained in the December 1996 issue of the Statistical Bulletin.

statistics

Unemployment Unemployment is measured by the Quarterly National Household Survey (formerly the annual Labour Force Survey). The Live Register is not designed to measure unemployment. It includes part-time workers (those who work up to three days a week), seasonal and casual workers entitled to Unemployment Assistance or Unemployment Benefit.

Standardised unemployment

The Standardised Unemployment Rate (SUR) series in Table 8 is based on the estimated number of persons unemployed expressed as a percentage of the total economically active population (i.e. rates the labour force), using internationally comparable definitions of employment and unemployment, as recommended by the International Labour Office. Benchmark estimates of the SUR for April of each year are calculated from the Labour Force Survey/Quarterly National Household Survey. The monthly trend in the seasonally adjusted Live Register has been traditionally used to estimate the monthly SUR between successive surveys.

This approach was temporarily suspended following the rapid decline in the Live Register after September 1996. A linear interpolation estimation approach was used between April 1996 and April 1997, as the Live Register series could not be used as an indicator of monthly trends in unemployment during that period. The traditional estimation approach has been used from April 1997 onwards.

QNHS The Quarterly National Household Survey, which began in September 1997, has now replaced the Labour Force Survey and provides quarterly estimates of the unemployment rate. The estimates (unadjusted for seasonality) are:

Seasonal The seasonal adjustment of the Live Register is completed using the X-11 Variant of the US Buadjustment reau of Census Method 2 (Additive Option). The seasonally adjusted series are updated twice yearly, in January and July; pending the next updating, seasonal adjustment for intervening months is carried out using projected seasonal factors. In Tables 4a, b and c the seasonally adjusted totals are the sum of the relevant seasonally adjusted series for males and females, under and over 25 years.

> Because QNHS estimates are not yet adjusted for seasonality, only the March-May unemployment rates, which are directly comparable with April LFS data, have been incorporated in the calculation of the monthly SUR.
