

Annual decrease of over 39,000

There were 152,871 persons on the Live Register at the end of May this year, compared with 192,230 in May 1999. The annual decrease of 39,359 is the largest on record and the Live Register is now at its lowest level since June 1982.

During May this year, the Live Register fell by 8,925 persons. After adjusting for the effect of seasonal factors, this represents an underlying decrease of 4,300 during the month.

Other features include:

- ◆ There was a fall of 7,502 in the number of persons aged 25 or over signing on; and the number aged under 25 fell by 1,423 in the month. See Tables 1b and 1c.
- ♦ The number of UB claimants fell by 5,289 in May and the number of UA applicants fell by 3,111. See Table 1a.
- ♦ In the twelve months to May 2000, the number of UB claimants fell by 8,119 while the number of UA applicants fell by 29,356. There was an annual decrease of 1,884 in the number of other claimants. *See Table La*
- ◆ The Live Register fell in all regions during May. The largest fall was in the Dublin region (-2,460). *See Table 2*.
- ♦ The standardised unemployment rate in May was 4.6%. This compares with 5.7% in April 1999, based on the Quarterly National Household Survey. *See Table 8 and Background Notes*.

The Live Register is not designed to measure unemployment. It includes part-time workers (those who work up to three days a week), seasonal and casual workers entitled to Unemployment Assistance or Benefit. Unemployment is measured by the Quarterly National Household Survey and the latest figure, for September-November 1999, is 88,700 persons unemployed.

Central Statistics Office Live Register Statement

Background Notes

Source and The Live Register is compiled from returns made directly to the Central Statistics Office by each scope of the local office of the Department of Social, Community and Family Affairs. It comprises persons **Live Register** under 65 years of age in the following classes:

- All Claimants for Unemployment Benefit (UB) excluding systematic short-time workers (see Table 5);
- Applicants for Unemployment Assistance (UA) excluding smallholders/farm assists and self-employed persons (see Table 6);
- Other registrants including applicants for credited Social Welfare contributions but excluding those directly involved in an industrial dispute (see Table 6).

Descriptive The compilation basis for the Live Register statistics from May 1992 onwards is described in the September 1992 issue of the Statistical Bulletin. The March 1980 issue contained a description of the basis used up to April 1992 while a more comprehensive treatment of Live Register statistics appeared in the "Report of the Inter-Departmental Study Group on Unemployment Statistics" (Stationery Office Dublin, Prl. 7925, April 1979). The results of a special study of the differences between the Labour Force Survey (LFS) Estimates of Unemployment and the Live Register are contained in the December 1996 issue of the Statistical Bulletin.

statistics

Unemployment Unemployment is measured by the Quarterly National Household Survey (formerly the annual Labour Force Survey). The Live Register is not designed to measure unemployment. It includes part-time workers (those who work up to three days a week), seasonal and casual workers entitled to Unemployment Assistance or Unemployment Benefit.

Standardised unemployment

The Standardised Unemployment Rate (SUR) series in Table 8 is based on the estimated number of persons unemployed expressed as a percentage of the total economically active population (i.e. rates the labour force), using internationally comparable definitions of employment and unemployment, as recommended by the International Labour Office. Benchmark estimates of the SUR for April of each year are calculated from the Labour Force Survey/Quarterly National Household Survey. The monthly trend in the seasonally adjusted Live Register has been traditionally used to estimate the monthly SUR between successive surveys.

This approach was temporarily suspended following the rapid decline in the Live Register after September 1996. A linear interpolation estimation approach was used between April 1996 and April 1997, as the Live Register series could not be used as an indicator of monthly trends in unemployment during that period. The traditional estimation approach has been used from April 1997 onwards.

QNHS The Quarterly National Household Survey, which began in September 1997, has now replaced the Labour Force Survey and provides quarterly estimates of the unemployment rate. The estimates (unadjusted for seasonality) are:

Seasonal The seasonal adjustment of the Live Register is completed using the X-11 Variant of the US Buadjustment reau of Census Method 2 (Additive Option). The seasonally adjusted series are updated twice yearly, in January and July; pending the next updating, seasonal adjustment for intervening months is carried out using projected seasonal factors. In Tables 4a, b and c the seasonally adjusted totals are the sum of the relevant seasonally adjusted series for males and females, under and over 25 years.

> Because QNHS estimates are not yet adjusted for seasonality, only the March-May unemployment rates, which are directly comparable with April LFS data, have been incorporated in the calculation of the monthly SUR.
