




**Fig. 1.1 Annual birth, death and natural increase rates per 1,000 population**

This report has been prepared by the Central Statistics Office for the Minister for Social Protection in accordance with the provisions of Section 2 of the Vital Statistics and Births, Deaths and Marriages Registration Act, 1952, Section 73 of the Civil Registration Act 2004 and Government Order SI No. 831 of 2007.

### **Births**

There were 17,107 births registered in quarter 2 of 2013, 8,782 males and 8,325 females. The corresponding total for quarter 2 2012 was 851 higher at 17,958 births, while the quarter 2 2008 total was 1,933 higher at 19,040 births. The quarter 2 2013 total is 10.1% higher than in 2004 when 15,535 babies were registered. See tables 1a, 3, 4 and 5.

The 17,107 births represent an annual birth rate of 14.9 per 1,000 of the population, 0.8 below quarter 2 of 2012. This rate is 0.5 per 1,000 population lower than in 2004. See tables 1a, 4, 5 and fig. 1.1.

### **Birth order**

A total of 6,372 births (37.3%) were to first time mothers in quarter 2 of 2013. Second time mothers had 6,099 births (35.7%). First births in the second quarters of 2012 and 2008 accounted for 37.5% and 40.8% of all births respectively. The number of first births registered in quarter 2 2004 was 5,897 (38.8%). Birth order percentages are calculated using the number of live births with stated parity. See tables 1a, 3, 4, 6 and fig. 1.2.

### **Age of mothers**

The average age of mothers for births registered in quarter 2 2013 was 32.2 years, 0.3 years more than the corresponding figure in quarter 2 2012, 1.0 years more than in quarter 2 2008, and 1.4 years more than in quarter 2 2004. The average age of mothers having their first child in quarter 2 2013 was 30.2 years. See tables 3, 9 and fig. 1.3..

### **Births within civil partnership**

There were 2 births (0.01%) registered as being within civil partnership in quarter 2 2013.

### **Births outside marriage/civil partnership**


There were 5,824 births registered as outside marriage/civil partnership in quarter 2 of 2013. This accounted for 34.0% of all births, a decrease of 0.3 percentage points on quarter 2 2012 and an increase of 1.6 percentage points on quarter 2 2008. The highest percentage of births outside marriage/civil partnership was in Limerick City at 57.6%, while the lowest percentage of births outside marriage/civil partnership was in Dun Laoghaire Rathdown at 22.9%. Ten years earlier, in quarter 2 2004, 4,874 births were registered outside marriage or 31.4% of all births. See tables 1a, 3, 4, 8 and 10.

The average age of mothers at maternity outside of marriage/civil partnership, was 29.2 years. This ranged from 31.2 years in Dun Laoghaire Rathdown to 27.2 years in Offaly. See table 10.

### **Deaths**

There were 7,644 deaths registered in quarter 2 2013, 3,916 males and 3,728 females. The quarter 2 2013 total is 8% higher than in the corresponding quarter of 2012 and 1% higher than in quarter 2 2008, when 7,080 and 7,570 deaths were registered respectively. See tables 2 and 3.

The 7,644 deaths represent an annual death rate of 6.7 per 1,000 of the population, 0.5 above quarter 2 of 2012. This rate is 0.1 per 1,000 population lower than in 2004. See tables 2, 4, and fig. 1.1.

#### Age at death

There were 58 infant deaths registered in quarter 2 2013 giving an infant mortality rate of 3.4 deaths per 1,000 live births. Neonatal deaths are deaths of infants at ages under 4 weeks. There were 38 neonatal deaths registered in quarter 2 2013, a neonatal mortality rate of 2.2 deaths per 1,000 live births. See tables 3, 4 and fig. 1.4.

There were 6,206 deaths of persons aged 65 and over registered in quarter 2 2013. This represents an annual death rate of 43.7 per 1,000 population aged 65 and over and represents an increase of 2.7 when compared with the corresponding quarter of 2012. See tables 3 and 4.

#### Cause of death

- **Diseases of the Heart and Arteries:**

Diseases of the Circulatory System accounted for 2,436 deaths, or an annual rate of 2.1 per 1,000 population. Of these, 1,201 were due to Ischaemic Heart Disease and 515 to Cerebrovascular Disease. See tables 2, 14 and fig. 1.5.

- **Malignant Cancers:**

There were 2,147 deaths from malignant neoplasms. This is equivalent to an annual rate of 1.9 per 1,000 population. See tables 2, 14 and fig. 1.5.

- **Lung Diseases:**


Deaths from pneumonia numbered 294; chronic lower respiratory disease accounted for 468 deaths and 259 deaths resulted from other respiratory diseases. See tables 2, 14 and fig. 1.5.

- **Accidents, suicides and other:**

There were 353 deaths due to accidents, suicides and other external causes. Accidents accounted for 62% (219) of these deaths, while suicides accounted for 31.4% (111). Of these 353 deaths 69.4% were male. See tables 2, 14, 15 and fig. 1.5.

The leading cause of death in quarter 2 2013 varied widely by age group. Among young adults aged 15 to 34, external causes of death including accidents, suicide and other ranked first. Among individuals aged 35-74, cancers were the leading cause, while for those aged 75 and older, it was diseases of the heart and arteries. See table 14 and fig. 1.6.

## Natural increase

The natural increase in the population (births minus deaths) for quarter 2 2013 was 9,463. This represents a rate of 8.2 per 1,000 population, 1.3 per thousand lower than quarter 2 of 2012. See *tables 3, 4 and fig.1.1*.

## Marriages

The number of marriages registered during the quarter was 5,444, equivalent to an annual marriage rate of 4.7 per 1,000 population, the same as the corresponding quarter of 2012. The quarter 2 2013 total is 9.9% higher than in quarter 2 2004 when 4,953 marriages were registered. See *tables 3 and 4*.

## Civil Partnerships

Civil Partnership legislation was introduced in Ireland on the 4<sup>th</sup> January 2011. The number of civil partnerships registered in the second quarter of 2013 was 72. This is equivalent to an annual rate of 0.06 per 1,000 population and is 0.04 per 1,000 population below the rate for the corresponding quarter of 2012. See *tables 1a, 3 and 4*.

## Population

The estimated population (usual residence) in April 2013 was 4,593,100.

Infant and neonatal mortality rates in some areas, based on small numbers are subject to considerable fluctuation and caution should be exercised in their interpretation.

## Background Notes

### Methodology

All figures in this report are classified by quarter of registration. Delay in the registration of some births, deaths and marriages result in them being included in a later period in these quarterly reports.

### Changes in methodology

The extension of the Limerick City boundary, which came into operation on 1st March 2008, has been taken into account in the compilation of the statistics from the Second Quarter of 2008. As a result, data for Limerick City and County are not directly comparable with any quarter prior to the Second Quarter 2008.

This publication continues with the 3 major changes in the methods by which mortality statistics are compiled. These changes were introduced in the Vital Statistics First Quarter 2007 publication.

- 1) Underlying Cause of Death is classified according to International Classification of Diseases, Version 10 (ICD10) instead of to International Classification of Diseases, Version 9 (ICD9). In addition, this and future publications will incorporate certain official updates to ICD-10. In particular, mental and behavioural disorders due to psychoactive substance use (F10-F19), with mention of intestinal infectious diseases (A00-A09), accidental, intentional self and undetermined intent poisoning by and exposure to noxious substances (X40-X49, X60-X69, Y10-Y19) or assault by chemical or noxious substance (X85-X90), are now coded to the latter.

- 2) Deaths where there was not an inquest have been coded using the automated coding system developed by the U.S National Centre for Health Statistics (NCHS). Previously the Underlying Cause of Death was chosen manually for all deaths.
- 3) All deaths registered in the Quarter have been included in the statistics, in some cases with a provisional cause of death. Previously the practice was not to include deaths in the quarterly statistics until the cause of death had been definitely established.

Because of these changes, caution should be taken in directly comparing these mortality statistics with those of previous quarters. Many countries have found that moving to ICD10 does affect certain specific categories of causes of death. In particular, a significant drop in the number of deaths attributed to pneumonia and bronchopneumonia has been observed in some countries after moving to ICD10. These deaths were instead assigned to other conditions included on the death certificate.

The effect of the third change above has been to increase the number of deaths in our statistics as compared with previous years. Statistics for deaths due to external causes are particularly affected by this change. The previous method meant that some deaths were included in a later quarter of the year from when they had been registered, because of the delay involved in establishing a definite cause of death.

### Revised rates

This report contains revisions to previously published rates for Marriages, Births and Deaths with effect from the second quarter of 2006. This is due to revised population estimates and the change from using De Facto population data to Usual Residence population data. All rates for periods prior to the second quarter of 2006 remain unchanged. These revisions were first published in the Vital Statistics First Quarter 2012 report.

### Revised figures

This report contains upward revisions to previously published figures for births registered in quarter 3 of 2008, quarter 1 of 2009 and 2010, and also for the previously published numbers for deaths registered in quarter 1 of 2010 and 2011. The natural increase and totals for these years were also revised. These revisions were first published in the Vital Statistics Second Quarter 2011 report.

### Stated parity

Refers to the number of previous live births, excluding any not stated.
