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Housing and Households

Introduction

This chapter deals with housing and households. The statistics are taken from the Censuses of Population from 1926 to 1996 and, more recently, from the module on housing included in the Quarterly National Household Survey (QNHS) in quarter three of 1998. Some statistics on home computing, collected in the QNHS in 1998 and 2000, are also included in tables 17.13, 17.15 and 17.16.

Number and size of households

Tables 17.1 to 17.4 give a range of information on the number and size of households while table 17.5 classifies households by number of rooms. The number of private households has almost doubled since the 1926 Census, when there were 622,700 private households in the State. By 1991 the number had increased to 1,029,100 and in 1998 there were 1,227,300 private households. There were, on average, 4.48 persons per household in 1926. By 1991, average household size had fallen to 3.34 and the latest figure, for 1998, is 3.02 persons.

With the fall in the average size of household, houses have also become less crowded. In 1946, households contained an average of one person per room; this compares with 0.6 persons per room in 1998. Smaller dwellings were relatively more crowded: in 1998, one-room dwellings had an average of 1.09 persons per room while two-room dwellings had 0.7 persons per room. There were 45,500 dwellings with one or two rooms. There were almost 600,000 dwellings with between three and five rooms; and the number of persons per room was close to the national average in dwellings of this size. Those with six rooms or more had, on average, almost two rooms per person.

Household size varies at different stages in the family life cycle. Table 17.7 shows that households where the reference person was aged 35 to 54 were larger than average, with 3.83 persons; there were almost half a million households in this age category, many of them nuclear family units, ie parents and children. The density of persons per room was higher for these households, at 0.68 persons per room.

As the age of the reference person increases, household size decreases. In 1998, there were 171,200 households where the reference person was aged 55 to 64, with an average household size of 2.71 persons. The 282,300 households where the reference person was aged 65 or over had an average of 1.81 persons per household, with 0.38 persons per room.

Age and type of dwelling

In 1998 the majority of dwellings, almost 1.1 million, were houses. Of these, more than 500,000 were detached; 315,000 were semi-detached; and about 250,000 were terraced houses. Table 17.6 shows that about one in every seven dwellings in the Dublin region was a bedsitter or apartment.

The average size of household was lower for bedsitters and apartments, at 1.72 persons, than the national average; meanwhile the number of persons per room was above the overall average, at 0.7 persons.

About half of the housing stock (upward of 570,000 dwellings) was built before 1970. Table 17.10 gives a full breakdown by year of construction and shows that about 225,000 dwellings were built in the 1970s and a further estimated 310,000 since 1981.

Home ownership and rented accommodation

Table 17.11 gives information on home ownership and rented accommodation. Over 40% of all householders (538,200) owned their dwelling outright in 1998. In about 60% of these households, the reference person was aged 55 or over. Another 376,700 were paying a homeloan or mortgage; these were mostly households where the reference person was aged between 25 and 54.

Table 17.12 gives further information on the size of homeloan or mortgage repayments. In quarter three of 1998, over half of monthly payments were

under €381 per month. About 10% were paying between €509 and €635 per month; and an estimated 28,000 households were making a monthly payment of €636 or more.

About 200,000 dwellings were rented in quarter three of 1998. The reference person was aged under 35 in about half of rented dwellings, aged 35 to 54 in 32%, and aged 55 or over in 19% of rented dwellings.

Heating and related household equipment

Tables 17.13 and 17.14 show that, while over 80% of households had central heating in 1998, a substantial number used other methods of heating their home in winter. An estimated 123,500 households used open fires and/or portable heaters and 70,000 used closed solid fuel appliances for winter heating. The prevalence of central heating was lower among the elderly, in rented accommodation, in bedsitters or apartments, and in older dwellings.

Just under 70% of dwellings had a smoke alarm in 1998. Table 17.13 shows that the percentage was considerably below the national average in the West, in dwellings occupied by older residents, in rented dwellings, and in bedsitters or apartments. The majority of dwellings had a hot water cylinder but a quarter did not have a lagging jacket.

Home computing

In 2000, an estimated 416,900 households had a home computer. This represented almost a third of all households, compared with 18.6% in 1998. Home computers were primarily being used for education and leisure. The number of homes with an internet connection more than quadrupled, from 61,100 to 262,700, between 1998 and 2000. This meant that over a fifth of all households were connected to the internet in 2000.



Size of monthly mortgage, 1998


